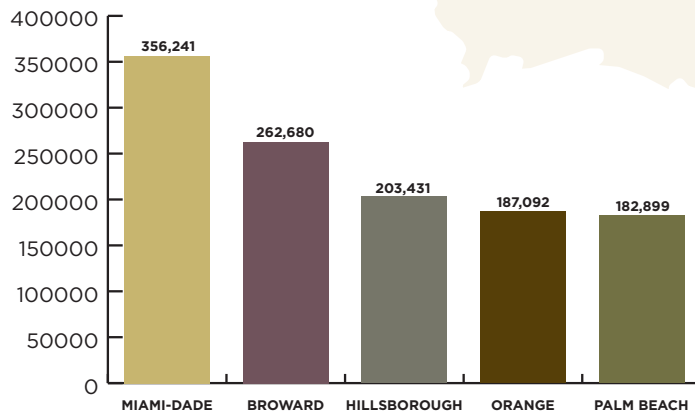

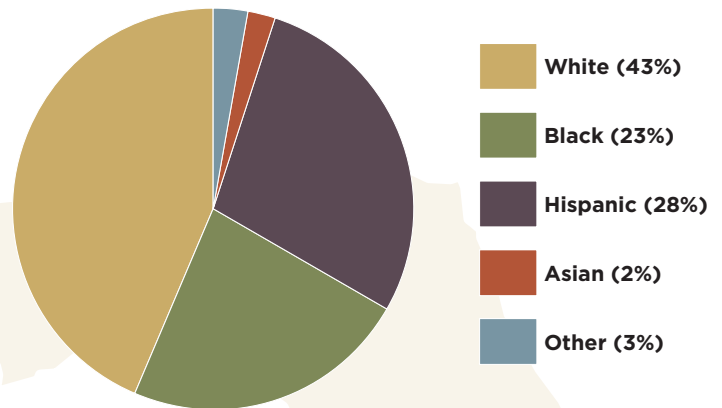

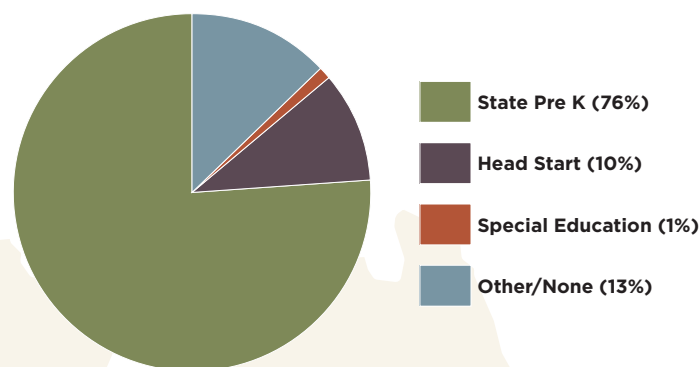

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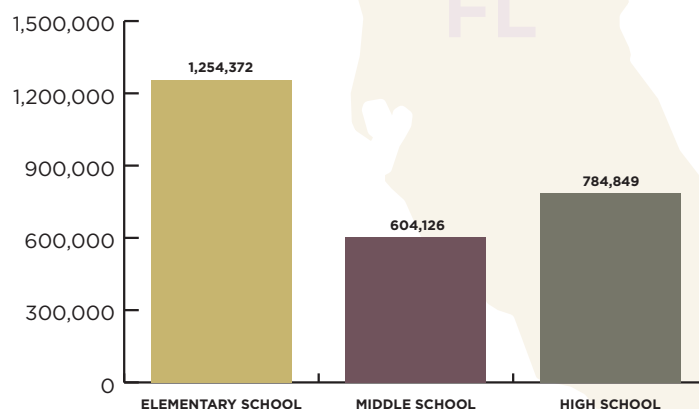

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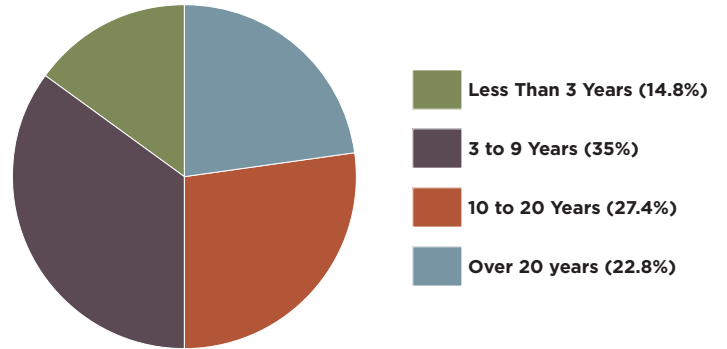

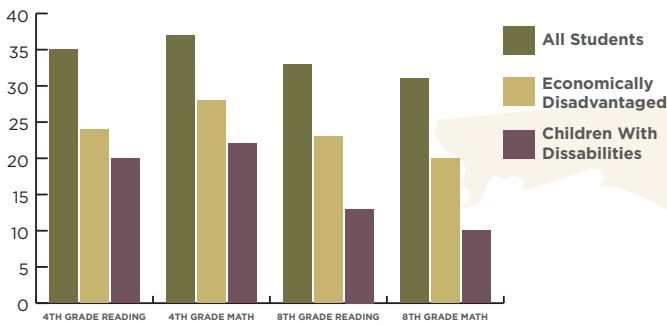

Student Performance on the National Assessment of Educational Progress (2011)²⁰

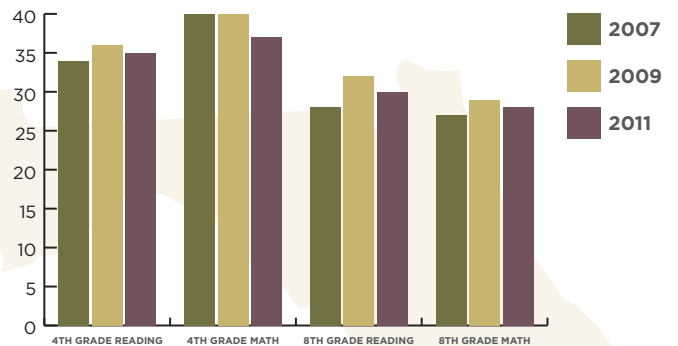

Percent of Students Scoring At or Above Proficient



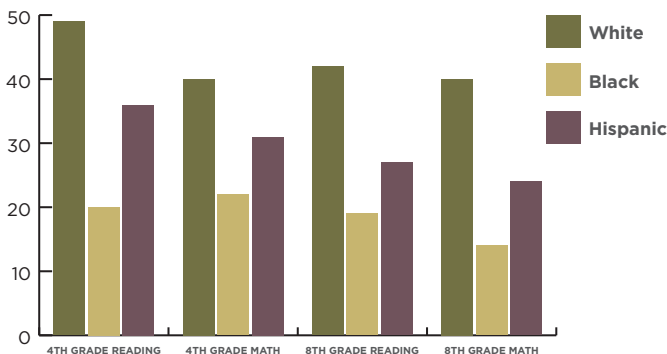

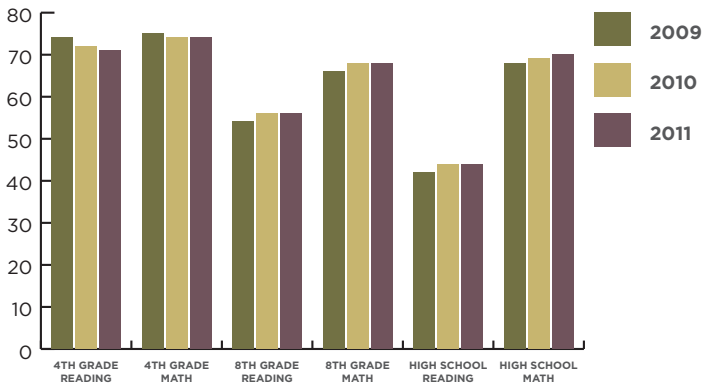

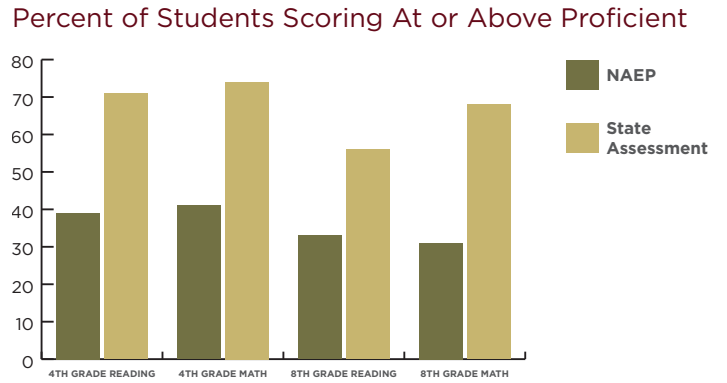

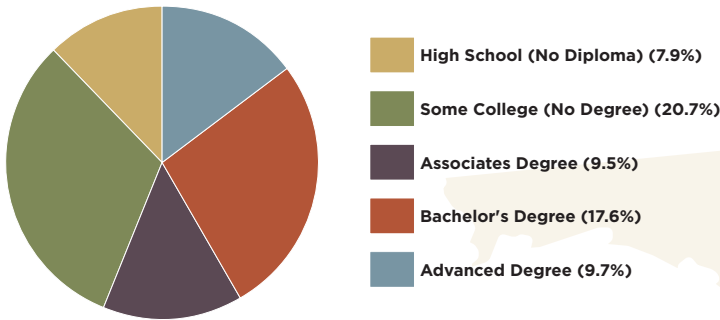
